

K30810 Hudson Lock Kit

This Hudson brand lock can be converted from a compartment door lock (with attached cam) or by changing the cam, be used as the tenant lock on the parcel compartment door. The design of this lock is such that if care in removing and replacing the nut securing the cam is not taken, there is a good chance the core of the lock will come out of the lock body.



The K30810 Hudson lock kit can be used for compartment doors (as shown with attached cam) or for tenant doors prepared for the USPS lock system. For the latter, the parcel cam shown on top is switched out. Due to the design of this lock, care must be taken to avoid the lock core from separating from the lock body.



To remove the compartment latch cam, first remove the key from the lock. Due to how easily the core can come loose from the lock body, hold the lock in such a manner that your thumb is pressed against the lock core as you remove the nut.



Continue to maintain pressure against the lock core as you insert the lock through the door lock opening. Once you have the lock started through the door opening, you could even grasp the threads of the lock from the inside of the door to keep the lock core in place until you've secured the lock with the provided clip. As you apply the parcel cam, large star washer, and nut, maintain pressure on the lock core from the front once again to keep the lock core in place until the nut is tightened.
