From the front, it looks like a wall-hanging mailbox, but it's actually embedded into the wall.

Our U-Post mailboxes combine the design of wall-hanging mailboxes with the storage capacity of embedded mailboxes.

Design reliably protects important pieces of mail from the rain

Your mail will stay dry on rainy days because the slot on each mailbox has a lid that keeps rain out, even rain that blows in sideways.



Compatible with all sorts of walls

Our U-Post mailboxes can be installed in walls as thick as 6 3/4". You can remove the back door to work on RC walls or renovation projects.



Large storage capacity despite small protrusion on back side

The part of the front side that sticks out is not only a visual design feature but is done to help reduce the protrusion on the back side and improve the storage capacity of the mailbox. Our mailboxes have 1.5 times the capacity of one-block mailboxes, which require the same amount of space to install.

Fine design features combination lock

The back door has a combination lock that is both safe and convenient since there is no need to carry around a key.

Damper cushioning prevents damage to lids

We have attached urethane damper cushioning to the lids of our mailboxes, which prevents damage to all parts from contact between the lids and other materials. The cushioning also muffles the sound of the lid opening and closing.



Outstandingly Convenient Back Door Design

The back door opens and closes with the hinge at the bottom, a first in the industry. This greatly improves the ease of use, especially when the mailbox is installed in the middle of a stairway or in a low position since there is no need to stoop to pick up the mail or peek inside with our design. The door is on a spring, too, so you can grab your mail with one hand while you hold an umbrella in your other.

Back Door Design

The back door of the mailbox faces your house, so you will see it every day. That's why we design it in the same way that we design the front side, complete with a matching color scheme.



Slot for magazines and catalogs

At 13 3/4", the slot is plenty long enough for a large catalog. It is 1 5/8" wide, combining storage capacity and safety since the mail carrier's hand won't get stuck in the slot, even for thick mail order catalogs.

Mailboxes feature a new material

We use light, strong fiberglass reinforced plastic (FPR, used in surfboards and boats) on our mailboxes, and the texture feels even more genuine than plaster or terra cotta. Craftsmen pour their hearts into making our mailboxes by hand, creating fine finished products that brim with a genuine feel. In addition, hinges and other metal parts are made of stainless steel.



Weather-resistant paint makes maintenance easy

The mailboxes are protected using acrylic urethane paint, which holds up well against the elements. Taking care of your mailbox is as easy as rinsing it with water or wiping it with a cloth. You can use a mild detergent diluted in water for persistent dirt and grime.
